**Documents needed with your application:**

- Birth Certificate-to ensure your child meets age requirements by September 30th
- Baptismal Certificate – if Catholic
- Immunization record and health form from physical exam since September 2011
- Current report card for grades 1-6
- Standardized test scores (if available) for grades 3-6
- If your child has been evaluated for any special needs (504 Plan, Title I, speech therapy, etc.), please provide the file information to us.
- List of medications your child is currently taking

**Application process**

- Submit your application with all the proper documentation and a non-refundable registration fee of \$175.00 per child. (Your payment will be refunded if your child is not accepted.) If your application is received by February 24, 2012, you may pay a discounted registration fee of \$150.00.
- Your application will be reviewed.
- A decision letter will be mailed regarding the acceptance of your child for school.
