## 2017-2018 Re-Registration

**Re-registration Forms** are enclosed. Determining an accurate projected enrollment is critical in creating the budget for the 2017-18 school year. We rely on your support in getting the registrations in as quickly as possible. The registration/ book fee remains the same as the past several years: \$175. As an incentive, an early enrollment fee of \$150 can be applied to families that register by **Thursday, February 9<sup>th</sup>**. Payment must be made when you submit the form to qualify for the reduced rate. If you wish to register a new sibling not currently enrolled, please request a new student registration form from the school office.

**Financial Aid:** Online applications for assistance are now available. Directions, web address and more detailed information for families interested in applying for financial assistance for the 2017-18 school year is enclosed. There is a \$30 yearly fee paid by parents requesting aid directly to FACTS for their services. Please call FACTS at 866-441-4637 if you have questions about completing your application. We will make financial aid awards after our budget is approved in this spring.

**Parish Tuition Support 2017-2018:** If you did not receive the parish rate for tuition this year and you want to receive that rate for next year, you must bring the green form (sent home with registration paperwork) to your parish. The priest must sign that form and return it to our school by March 1<sup>st</sup>. Please be sure to give the parishes plenty of time to process your form.
