### Peeking into Grade 6

With a very successful Science Fair behind us, the 6<sup>th</sup> grade is now exploring the world of protists and fungi. The students have been collecting samples of pond water and will observe their habits, movements, and characteristics under the microscope. There have been some interesting discussions on the "good and bad" fungus in our lives and the benefits of both. We are in the middle of our unit on fractions. What a difference a year makes!!! The 6<sup>th</sup> graders have definitely become experts with the operations of fractions. Our next step is for the students to be able to shop at the mall and figure out using percents, what their marked down summer clothes will cost. Be prepared parents for your children to surprise you! Our class has 2 great field trips this spring. Last week we traveled to Lowell Mills to experience an Ecology hands-on science lab. The students learned importance of keeping our water supply clean.
