- ◆ **ASP payments:** Just a reminder, ASP payments are expected to **paid by Friday of every week** for families utilizing the daily rate. Please keep track of how many days your child(ren) attend that week and send in payment to school by Friday morning. Payments can also be left with Miss Cheryl or Miss Angela when you pick up your child. Parents of full-time ASP students pay a yearly fee in weekly or monthly installments (like tuition payments). The total yearly amount is due regardless of absences or days school is not in session but reflects a discounted rate. Weekly payments are also due every Friday. Monthly payments are due by the 30th of each month. Invoices for overdue balances for all ASP participants are enclosed. Thank you for your help and cooperation.

Time to Re-register ~ 2018-2019 School year

Enclosed you will find the re-registration form. Because we now utilize the Option C student management program the process is very easy! Just check the information, sign and return with payment! All re-registrations are due by February 8th. We rely on your support in getting the registrations in as quickly as possible. The registration/ book fee remains the same as the past several years: \$175. As an incentive, an early enrollment fee of \$150 can be applied to families that register by **Thursday, February 8th**.
