Peeking into....Grade 2

Second grade is off to a great start! In science we started by discussing the scientific method and practicing using different science tools. Now, we have started our unit on living and nonliving things. We have planted beans in plastic bags to see how the roots form before we move them to soil. In math, we are learning the math facts that are necessary for success in our math program. Each week, the students add a new set of facts to their fact bags for practice. In Social Studies, we are taking a close look at our communities and the communities around us. We have discussed the difference between urban, suburban and rural communities and we are focusing on community workers and how they help us every day. Our first story in our reading program was The Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle. The children were able to experiment with water colors and the techniques that Eric Carle uses to make their own beautiful pictures! We have been discussing the Sacrament of Baptism in Religion. We have learned the different symbols that are present in Baptism and we were able to look at some pictures from the students own Baptisms to see the different symbols. It is such a delight to work with this group of eager learners. I look forward to an exciting school year!
