Halloween Celebration & Parade

The annual Halloween Parade will be held on Monday Oct. 31st. The children will be allowed to wear costumes to school but please follow these guidelines:

- **Come to school dressed in costume (over dress-down clothing)** – there will not be time to get ready at school. Younger children must be able to remove and pack their own items. Please provide a bag.
- **Refrain from makeup.** Any makeup worn must be easily removed by the student after the parade. Don't bring makeup or hair products to school.
- **Age appropriate & "family friendly"** costumes (not representative of anything violent or suggestive)
 - **No masks, or weapons** (or props that can be used as a weapon.)



The parade will begin at 8:00 AM in the school playground and proceed around to the main entrance. We hope to see many of our parents in attendance. Parents who attend are asked to park in the church parking lot. After the parade, the children will remove their costumes and the school day will proceed in dress-down clothing. Each teacher will designate their own time to enjoy Halloween party treats.

Peeking into...Grade 3

The third graders are off to a good start. They have finally put their summer brains away and are plugged into school. We are reviewing addition and subtraction strategies and everyone should be studying their facts each night to achieve mastery. In Science, we are studying the three states of matter and learning that each can change with the addition of heat. They are working on writing a story about what they love about autumn. We are discussing parts of the writing process: first draft, editing, sequencing words, second draft, and final draft. In Religion, we are learning about the three Sacraments of Christian Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. We also discuss how we can live our lives more like Jesus with the Holy Spirit as our guide. They love the new addition to our daily routine: center time. This 30 minute period, three times a week, gives them opportunities to further explore writing, addition, poetry, science, art, number sense and so much more. It also allows me to work one on one or with small groups of children. I am loving this wonderful group of students you have blessed me with and know we are going to have a great year!
