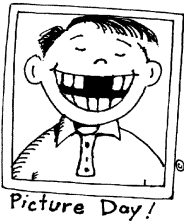

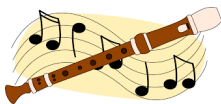

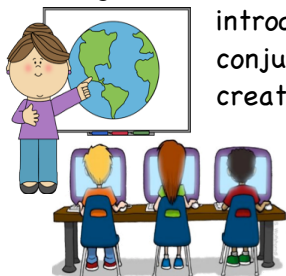

### Peeking into...Technology

It's been three weeks and all our technology classes are now fully in stride. We are getting used to our new classroom procedures and learned about basic computer knowledge and online safety. Last week, the students had fun exploring [netsmartzkids.org](http://netsmartzkids.org) website. There will be lots of hands-on activities this year. We will continue exploring all kinds of amazing things. PK and K students will be focusing on developing their navigational and mouse skills while 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders will be learning how to utilize the different Paintbrush and MS Word tools. MS PowerPoint will be introduced in 4<sup>th</sup> Grade and our 6<sup>th</sup> Graders will be creating a slideshow project in conjunction with their History class. 5<sup>th</sup> Graders, however, will be moving into creating three different desktop publishing projects: brochure, menu, and newsletter.
