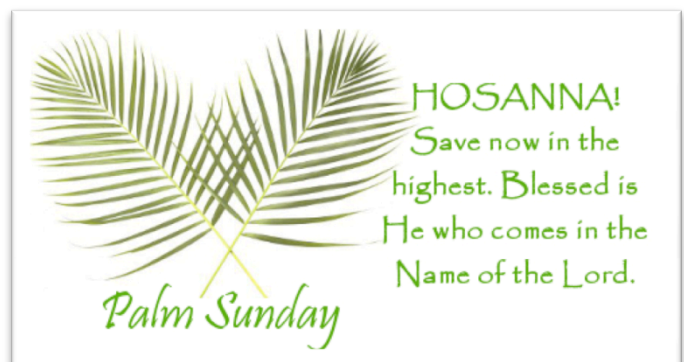
LIBERTY HOUSE LENTEN PROJECT: Thank for the wonderful response! We will continue to accept the children's donations through Easter.
